



The Whistler2020 process in 2010-2011 and its relationship to the OCP update

1. Will we have a Whistler2020 task force/action planning process in 2010?

Yes, there will be an active Whistler2020 process in 2010; however, it will be a different form due to the Official Community Plan (OCP) update this year. Whistler2020 task forces will be involved directly in the OCP update through representation on the Community Advisory Group, working groups, and review of the Descriptions of Success. The annual action planning process will be moved to the fall and refocused slightly: rather than prioritizing new actions for 2011, task forces will review and refine 2011 actions already proposed during the 2009 process.



2. How is the Whistler2020 task force process in 2010 different from previous years?

We committed to reviewing the Whistler2020 Descriptions of Success (DoS) after five years of Whistler2020 action planning, and 2010 is the year for this review. All of the task forces will meet to review the DoS in June to make sure they still accurately describe Whistler's vision for the year 2020 within each strategy area. Also, the task forces will be directly involved through the fall in the OCP working groups that will provide content into the OCP chapters. Our Apres in Action event this year will be focused on seeking input on the key issues for the OCP rather than for task force action planning. However, there will be some action review/refinement this fall for 2011 actions already proposed in 2009 process.

3. Will the Whistler2020 task force process resume in 2011?

Yes but, as usual, the process will be somewhat new and improved from 2009. We will take the results and recommendations from the independent Whistler2020 evaluation and incorporate them into the Whistler2020 process moving forward.

4. How will Whistler2020 be used to inform Whistler's OCP update?

Whistler2020 is the community's highest level policy and therefore will guide the development of the OCP by enshrining its sustainability vision and principles. While Whistler2020 is a vision and policy, the OCP is a regulatory document; together they will articulate and enshrine our resort community's vision and values.

5. How will the Whistler2020 task forces be engaged in the OCP



update?

Each task force nominated and voted for a member to form the Community Advisory Group. The task forces will also, along with members of the community, form the OCP working groups that will be convened in the fall to provide input and content into the OCP chapters. In June, the task forces will review the Whistler2020 Descriptions of Success, which will guide the development of the OCP.

6. What is the composition and role of the Community Advisory Group?

The Community Advisory Group is made up of 20 Whistler citizens: 15 Whistler2020 community task force representatives; four community members appointed by RMOW Council; and one youth representative. The role of the OCP Community Advisory Group is to advise the Resort Municipality of Whistler (RMOW) OCP Coordinating Team on the format, structure, and policies of the OCP update, and ensure alignment with Whistler2020.
