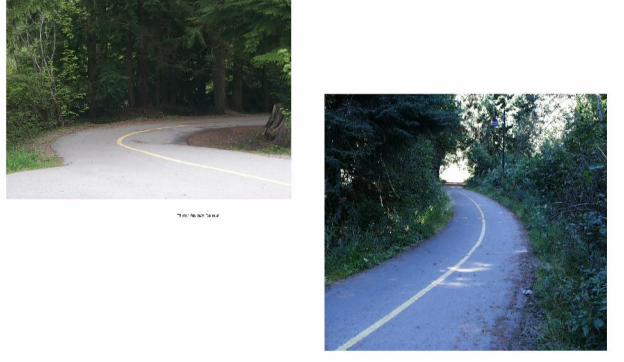






# RECREATION CYCLING TRAILS PLAN


<p><b>WHISTLER CYCLING COMMITTEE</b></p> <p><b>TECHNICAL DIFFICULTY RATING</b></p> <p><b>Type 1 - Easiest</b></p> <p><b>General Description:</b> Paths for kids and parents, suitable for all users.</p> <p><b>Examples:</b> Valley Trail around Whistler Golf Course.</p>  <p>Type 1 displayed on map: Existing Trail: Solid orange line Potential New Trail: Dashed orange line Potential Trail Rebuild: Dashed orange line with orange circles</p>	<p><b>WHISTLER CYCLING COMMITTEE</b></p> <p><b>TECHNICAL DIFFICULTY RATING</b></p> <p><b>Type 2 - Easy</b></p> <p><b>General Description:</b> Good choice and widely available, suitable for most users.</p> <p><b>Examples:</b> The Track, Valley Trail, Lost Lake, Mountain View, Mountain View, Mountain View.</p>  <p>Type 2 displayed on map: Existing Trail: Solid green line Potential New Trail: Dashed green line Potential Trail Rebuild: Dashed green line with green circles</p>	<p><b>WHISTLER CYCLING COMMITTEE</b></p> <p><b>TECHNICAL DIFFICULTY RATING</b></p> <p><b>Type 3 - More Difficult</b></p> <p><b>General Description:</b> Challenging trails with more than three technical obstacles, suitable for a competent trail user with good technique. Requires ability to negotiate and recover from.</p> <p><b>Examples:</b> Lost Lake, Mountain View, Mountain View, Mountain View.</p>  <p>Type 3 displayed on map: Existing Trail: Solid blue line Potential New Trail: Dashed blue line Potential Trail Rebuild: Dashed blue line with blue circles</p>	<p><b>WHISTLER CYCLING COMMITTEE</b></p> <p><b>TECHNICAL DIFFICULTY RATING</b></p> <p><b>Type 4 - Most Difficult</b></p> <p><b>General Description:</b> A variety of trail types, suitable for most trail users, requires advanced skills to ride in long runs, requires good technique and ability to negotiate and recover from.</p> <p><b>Examples:</b> All the Trails, Mountain View, Mountain View, Mountain View.</p>  <p>Type 4 displayed on map: Existing Trail: Solid black line Potential New Trail: Dashed black line</p>	<p><b>WHISTLER CYCLING COMMITTEE</b></p> <p><b>TECHNICAL DIFFICULTY RATING</b></p> <p><b>Type 5 - Expert Unlimited</b></p> <p><b>General Description:</b> Trail users require the most challenging conditions, high risk level. Only a handful of users will enjoy this type.</p> <p><b>Examples:</b> Canyon, Clay Falls, Lost Lake, Mountain View.</p>  <p>Type 5 displayed on map: Existing Trail: Solid red line</p>

\*A Trail Rebuild designates an existing trail that would be rebuilt to a lower technical difficulty type (i.e. Type 3 trail rebuilt to Type 2)



This map shows the proposed type, general location and intensity of land use in both developed and undeveloped parts of the Municipality. Land use designations are categorized according to dominant use, but may allow and support a mix of uses and other activities. For example, the core commercial designation also allows residential tourist accommodation, medium-density residential or institutional uses. Land use designation boundaries are general and do not necessarily conform to property lines.
